

Parent Referral Programme 2025/2026

Wesley Methodist School Ipoh International and Private (WMSII / WMSIP)

As part of our ongoing commitment to building a strong and supportive school community, we are pleased to offer the **Parent Referral Programme** for the 2025/2026 academic year. Parents of students currently enrolled at WMSII or WMSIP who successfully refer a new family to enrol at either school will be eligible to receive a **RM500 rebate** on their child's next term school fees. In appreciation, the referred family will also enjoy **50% discount on the application fee and registration fee**, subject to full payment of the first semester fees.

We thank you for your continued support in recommending WMSI to others.

Terms & Conditions

1. This programme is valid from:
 - **1st September 2025 to 31st August 2026** for **WMSII**, and
 - **1st January 2026 to 31st December 2025** for **WMSIP**.
2. Staff members of WMSII and WMSIP are **not eligible** to participate.
3. Rebates are applicable **only for successful referrals**, i.e., where the referee completes the full enrolment process.
4. A "**successfully enrolled**" student is defined as one who has been formally accepted and has completed the full registration process at WMSII or WMSIP.
5. The **Referrer** must:
 - Be a current parent with a child fully enrolled and
 - Have paid the **full first semester's fees**
 - Have **no outstanding payments** with WMSII/WMSIP
6. The **Referee** must:
 - Be a **new parent** enrolling for the first time at WMSII/WMSIP
 - Have paid the **full first semester's fees** (excluding short-term programme fees)
 - Have **no outstanding payments**
 - Not be eligible for any other discount or be referred through an agent
 - Rebates are **non-transferable** and **non-exchangeable for cash**, including in the event of withdrawal.
7. The school management reserves the right to amend or discontinue the programme or its terms without prior notice.

FAQ

Can a newly enrolled parent be a referrer to their friends?

Yes, they can. However, they will only receive the RM500 rebate in the following semester.

Note: A WMSII/WMSIP parent cannot also be a referee to the same person he/she has referred.

Can a WMSI parent recommend more than one applicant and receive more rebates?

Yes, A WMSII/WMSIP parent will receive a RM500 rebate per successful student recommended.

When will the WMSII/WMSIP parent receive their rebate?

WMSII/WMSIP parents will only receive their rebate once the referee(s)/new applicant(s) have paid up their 1st-semester fees.

Is the rebate transferable?

No. The rebate is not transferable nor can be exchanged for cash. In the event a student withdraws from the school, the rebate will be void.

Can a WMSI parent whose child has graduated from WMSII/WMSIP participate/refer an applicant?

Yes, they can however only the applicant will receive the 50% application fee discount and the 50% registration fee rebate. The WMSII/WMSIP parent will only receive a token souvenir from WMSII/WMSIP.

What if a WMSII/WMSIP parent only has a child at year 11 and cannot utilize the rebate in the following semester?

In this situation, a credit note will be issued and a refund in the stated amount will be given when the student officially graduates in the following semester.

What if more than one WMSII/WMSIP parent recommend the same new applicant?

Only one WMSII/WMSIP parent can receive the RM500 rebate based on a new applicant. In the event of contesting claims, WMSII/WMSIP will refer to the Parent Referral Programme form and decide based on when the school received a valid form with the corresponding signatures.
